1. Membership is open to (a) any individual who supports the aims and objectives of Scottish Rural Action (b) any non-statutory corporate body which supports the aims and objectives of Scottish Rural Action (c) any individual who has been nominated for membership by an unincorporated body which supports the aims and objectives of Scottish Rural Action.
2. Members have full voting rights at general meetings. Associate members do not have voting rights.
3. The liability of each member is limited to £1.
4. The directors may, at their discretion, refuse to admit any person or body to membership.
5. The directors shall consider each application for membership at the first directors' meeting which is held after receipt of the application (and accompanying remittance).
6. Membership subscription will be set and charged at the discretion of the directors.
7. A member may not transfer his/her/its membership to any other person.
